Selection process	On merit basis, through an online written test (50 MCQs, Syllabus: B-Optometry)
Online examination	All eligible candidates will be informed about the online admission examination details by email to their registered email address in advance. Also, a mock examination will be conducted to familiarize applicants with the online examination platform.
Last date of application	May 24, 2025
Date of online examination	June 1, 2025
Application fee	INR 1180/- (including of GST)
Internship course fee	INR 1,20,360/- (Tuition fee: INR 1,02,000/- + GST INR 18,360/-)
Food charges	If a trainee chooses to stay in the hostel, INR 30,000/- amount for six months to be paid at the time of admission (charges are campus specific)
Accommodation	Shared accommodation provided on the campus at no cost to the trainee
