




UVEITIS AND MEDICAL RETINA FELLOWSHIP



Eligibility: Post-graduation in ophthalmology


Duration: Three years

Number of fellowships on offer: Four fellowships per year

(national/international)


Application process: Written evaluation and interviews conducted in May and November, each year





The fellowship will train you to develop:

- Comprehensive expertise in the diagnosis and management of uveitis, including complex cataract surgeries, immuno-suppressive therapy, and basic rheumatological evaluation of patients
- Proficiency in the diagnosis and management of common medical retinal conditions, including interpretation of retinal imaging tools and competency in retinal lasers and injections





Timeline of Fellowship

Month 0-9

- Comprehensive traing in all sub-specialities
- Competency in routine cataract surgery
- Introduction to uveitis

Month 10-21

- Comprehensive practice in secondary centres including in hihg-volume cataract surgeries
- participation in all academic sessions on uveitis and medical retina

Month 22-30

- Intensive sub-specialty training on uveitis and medical retina
- Management of complex (uveitic) cataract surgeries
- Retinal lasers and injections

Month 31-36

- Independent outpatient clinics
- Rheumatology rotation (weekly, 3 months)
- Rotation in other LVPEI campuses
